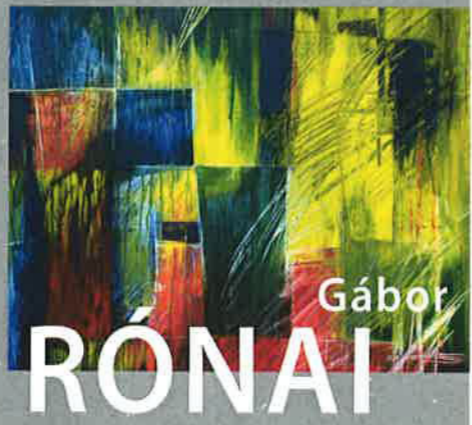
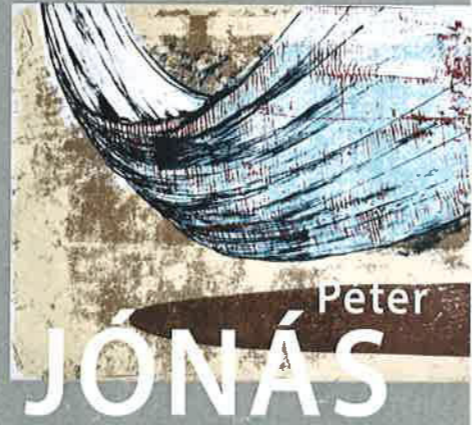
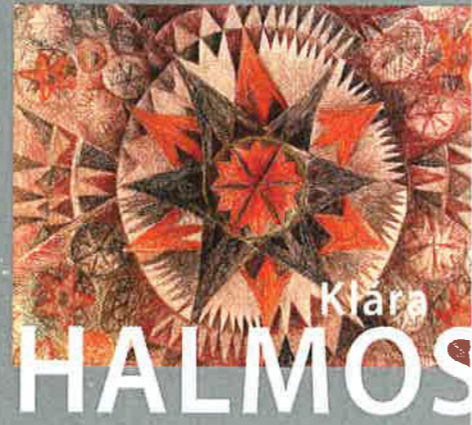
In 2015 Kapos ART Fine and Applied Arts Association celebrates its 25th anniversary of its existence. The association is a founding member of the Association of Hungarian Fine And Applied Artists. From its home in Kaposvár, it operates as a cooperation of artists from around the country and from abroad since its inception. The result of this cooperation are numerous exhibitions and professional workshops held during its two and a half decade in existence. Kapos ART is an active participant in the art life of Kaposvár and Hungary for 25 years. An active participant of the City of Painters Atmosphere Festival/Rippl-Rónai Festival since the beginning. Open-air flag art-shows, such as "Water Curtain", "Foreshore" Image Sequence of Digital Prints (installation), Rippl-Rónai and HER exhibition. New young members are constantly recruited, and the leadership of the association founded its Youth Section in 2015. It operates Kapos ART Contemporary Gallery. Since the 2013/14 season it organizes the PURELY Contemporary exhibition series at the Gallery of Csiky Gergely Theater. Since 1991, Kapos ART organizes an international art workshop in the city of Barcs annually. In 1997 it created the Foundation for the International Art Workshop of Barcs to support the workshop. Its members are actively participating in the organization of the workshops. Also in 1991, it announces and organizes the unique Grotesque Fine and Applied Arts Triennial, held at fifth time in 2015, and made it an international event by then. For two decades Kapos ART was also the organizer of the International MAIL ART, Postcards from Central and Eastern Europe exhibition. The association has an International Grotesque Collection, a Collection from Art Workshops, and an International MAIL ART Collection. The international connections of the association developed through twinning associations from Glinde (Germany), Saint Sebastien sur Loire (France), Schio (Italy), and Bath (UK). The annual art workshops also helped deepen the personal and professional relationship among artists from Székelyudvarhely, Nagyvárad, Kolozsvár of Transylvania. The association published three catalogues, at 1998, 2000, and 2008. With the Museum of Körös Region of Nagyvárad (Muzeul Tarii Crisurilor, Oradea) Kapos ART published a joint catalogue titled "Impossible Pictures". With the Barabás Miklós Guild of Kolozsvár published "Essentia" for their joint exhibition; Kapos ART participated in the "PEOPLE-metr 2013" International Wandering Exhibition with the Visegrad countries. It was exhibited in Prague (Czech), Trnava (Slovakia), Czestochowa (Poland). A selection of prominent exhibitions of the associations include an event Bath Society of Arts at Victoria Gallery of Bath, at Vigadó Gallery in Budapest, Gallery of Pécs, Gallery of Miskolc, Schio (Italy), Cifra Palace of Kecskemét, Nantes among others. In 2016 Kapos ART received the award "For the City of Kaposvár", for its participation in the art and cultural life of Kaposvár.
